

# Staff and Visitor Directions COVID-19

## Guideline

Staff & Volunteers	Visitors	Direct Client Care Contractors (Agency staff, GPs, Allied Health Professionals, Hairdressers)	Other Contractors (Plumbers, Electricians, HVAC, Gardeners)
<u>Masks</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn by all staff at Community Options</li> <li>Can be removed when in an office area alone, with the door closed.</li> </ul> <u>Vaccinations</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must conduct a RAT test prior to commencement of work if they have been off work, through absence or rostered day off, for more than 2 days.</li> <li>Must conduct a RAT every 72 hours</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they must not attend work, notify (rostering and) their line manager immediately, so contact tracing can take place and the shift can be covered.</li> <li>If a staff member has been exposed to COVID-19, they must inform a line manager and may be advised to conduct additional testing.</li> </ul>	<u>Masks</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to be worn</li> </ul> <u>Vaccinations</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to have up-to-date influenza and COVID vaccinations</li> </ul> <u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not Required to perform a RAT prior to entering a SCC(WA) facility.</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul> <u>Visitor Limits</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No restrictions on number of visitors when there is no infectious disease outbreak</li> <li>Visitor restrictions may be implemented on assessment of infectious disease outbreak</li> </ul>	<u>Masks</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn when at Community Options</li> </ul> <u>Vaccinations</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Recommended to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must conduct a RAT every day they enter or work at a SCC(WA) facility</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul>	<u>Masks</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn when at Community Options</li> </ul> <u>Vaccinations</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Recommended to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not Required to perform a RAT prior to entering a SCC(WA) facility.</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul> <u>Exemptions</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Delivery drivers are not required to have up-to-date vaccinations but are recommended to wear a mask if entering the facility</li> </ul>
