

# Staff and Visitor Directions COVID-19

<p><u>Masks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Surgical masks must be worn when working within 1.5m of a resident indoors at a Residential Aged Care Facility</li> <li>Masks do not need to be worn when not providing direct resident care.</li> </ul> <p><u>Vaccinations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <p><u>RATs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must conduct a RAT every 3 days (76 hours), prior to the commencement of work</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they must not attend work, notify (rostering and) their line manager immediately, so contact tracing can take place and the shift can be covered.</li> <li>If a staff member has been exposed to COVID-19, they must inform a line manager and may be advised to conduct additional testing.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Masks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Surgical masks are recommended to be worn when at a Residential Aged Care Facility</li> </ul> <p><u>Vaccinations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to have up-to-date influenza and COVID vaccinations</li> </ul> <p><u>RATs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must perform a RAT prior to entering a SCC(WA) facility.</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul> <p><u>Visitor Limits</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No restrictions on number of visitors when there is no infectious disease outbreak</li> <li>Visitor restrictions may be implemented on assessment of infectious disease outbreak</li> </ul> <p><u>Other Considerations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If visitor is visibly unwell and is displaying symptoms, should be advised that they should not attend, alternate visiting arrangement can be made but can be provided face mask and informed not to perform visits in common areas</li> </ul>	<p><u>Masks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Surgical masks must be worn when working within 1.5m of a resident indoors at a Residential Aged Care Facility</li> <li>Masks do not need to be worn when not providing direct resident care.</li> </ul> <p><u>Vaccinations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <p><u>RATs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must conduct a RAT every day they enter or work at a SCC(WA) facility</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Masks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Surgical masks are recommended but are not required when at a Residential Aged Care Facility</li> </ul> <p><u>Vaccinations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recommended to have up-to-date Influenza vaccination</li> <li>Recommended to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19</li> </ul> <p><u>RATs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not Required to perform a RAT prior to entering a SCC(WA) facility.</li> <li>If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible, so contact tracing can take place.</li> </ul>
