<u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must conduct a RAT every day before the commencement of work. If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they must not attend work and notify (rostering and) their line manager immediately so contact tracing can occur and the shift can be covered. If a staff member has been exposed to COVID-19, they must inform a line manager and may be advised to conduct additional testing. 	<u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must perform a RAT before entering a SCC(WA) facility. If they conduct a RAT and test positive, they are advised to notify their site contact as soon as possible so contact tracing can occur. 	<u>RATs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must conduct a RAT every day they enter or work at an SCC(WA) facility. 	<u>Visitor Limits</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No restrictions on the number of visitors when there is no infectious disease outbreak. Visitor restrictions may be implemented on the assessment of infectious disease outbreaks. 		

Other Considerations: If a visitor is visibly unwell and displays any cold, flu or gastro symptoms, they should be advised not to attend; alternate visiting arrangements can be made.
