Beneficial design features

East Fremantle residents have access to a broad range of amenities and services within a luxury setting including fine dining and extensive indoor and outdoor spaces.

The family café, and multiple shared outdoor areas provide the perfect setting for a walk or to sit and have a cup of tea while enjoying the fresh air.

In the kitchen, our experienced chefs take great pride in preparing fresh, nutritionally balanced meals with a range of options to cater for the dietary needs of each resident. Residents enjoy meals in the formal or casual dining areas, with the option of private in-room dining where requested.

East Fremantle residents can choose how and where they spend their time, whether it's joining an art session, or watching a movie in the in-house movie theatre.

Personalised care

Our residents are supported around the clock by our dedicated care team, with qualified nurses available onsite at all times. Regular visits from GPs and allied health professionals, including occupational therapists, podiatrists and physiotherapists, ensure residents have access to the right medical and therapeutic support.

Alongside this, residents can enjoy a varied program of daily activities and events designed to encourage connection, wellbeing and a sense of fun.

For residents living with dementia, our Dementia Support team works closely with families and care staff to develop a personalised support plan to ensure the resident is comfortable and happy in their surroundings.

Common areas

We have created spaces that provide a welcoming and caring environment for residents and their families to enjoy, including a family café which can accommodate visits from family members for morning/afternoon tea with residents and is conveniently located near court-yards and kids play areas.

The home also features an eight-seat movie theatre with 130" screen, on-site salon for hair dressing and nail care, a spacious lounge room and library.

Southern Cross Care East Fremantle also has gardens designed for our residents living with dementia, to enjoy the outdoors.



Residential aged care fees

Aged care fees depend on your financial situation, which is worked out through a means assessment of your income and assets.

Accommodation costs

This is the amount some people pay to help with or cover the full cost of their room. The amount depends on the results of the means assessment.

Basic daily fee

This is a set government fee that everyone pays for daily living expenses and services. It is the same for all individuals and does not depend on income or assets. The government updates this fee twice a year.

Non-Clinical Care Contribution (NCCC)

A means tested fee for non-clinical aged care services, such as bathing and mobility assistance this has a yearly and annual cap.*

Hotelling contribution

Means tested payment for residents with sufficient income and assets will make towards their everyday living costs and basic services.*

Payment options defined

Residents have a choice on how they wish to pay for their accommodation. Residents are required to complete a Centrelink assessment which, determines eligibility for government financial assistance for their accommodation.

- Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), which is an upfront amount paid by a resident for entry into residential care.
- Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), which is a daily payment amount.
- A combination of RAD and DAP, which is where a resident makes an upfront payment of a portion of the RAD and the remainder is paid as a DAP. For illustrative purposes, this has been shown in the table below as 50 per cent RAD and 50 per cent DAP.

Room types

Each of our 83 hotel 5-star standard rooms have been designed with maximum comfort and safe access for residents, including: East Fremantle has four wings featuring a range of room types:

- Classic rooms
- Deluxe rooms
- Premier rooms
- Grand deluxe rooms

All rooms include:

- Private ensuite bathrooms
- · Luxury electronically adjustable beds
- Built-in wardrobe with shelving and armchair, bedside tables with lockable drawer space and over-bed tables
- · Premium bed linen, towels and toiletries
- Easily accessible 24/7 nurse call buttons
- Air-conditioning, telephone and flat-screen LED TV with internet connections
- Large windows with courtyard, garden or coastal view
- Larger rooms may also have sitting areas and or writing tables
